HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

The Director(s) recognises that they have ultimate responsibility for health and safety. The Company's objective is to cause zero harm; accidents, injuries and work related ill health are not inevitable and the Company is committed to continual improvement in safety performance, its ultimate goal being ZERO INJURIES.

Project Management Teams are responsible for ensuring that the highest standards of occupational health and safety are established, and the highest standards of awareness maintained. Health and safety shall be a continual consideration for Management, Supervision and Operatives at all levels within the Company. Commitment to the principals of the Company's Health and Safety Policy and to attaining its goals is an essential core value and must be clearly demonstrated at all times.

The Company requires that all persons engaged by it or associated with its undertakings take responsibility for their own compliance with the Company's health and safety Policies, Procedures and practices relating to the activities being undertaken. All Directors, Managers, Supervisors, Operatives and Sub-Contractors engaged by the Company must be responsible for their own personal health and safety and also that of their colleagues and others who might be affected by their work.

In all aspects of the Company's activities, all applicable health and safety Legislation, Codes of Practice and associated Guidance shall be complied with and the Company shall take all reasonably practicable steps to meet or exceed its responsibilities under the Health & Safety at Work, etc. Act 1974 and subsequent Regulations, Approved Codes of Practice, Guidance Notes and other industry best practice.

To assure this, the Company shall provide the necessary resources to achieve its aims including sufficient competent health and safety advice to ensure its Policies and Standards are rigorously applied. Higher levels of performance will be pursued where reasonable and there will be the closest co-operation with those with who we interface during the carrying out of the Company's undertakings. The Company shall ensure its collaboration in the promotion of a positive safety culture and maintenance of high standards and continuous improvement.

This Policy is reviewed annually to reflect the Company's continual awareness for, the improvement in and the promotion of the highest standards of occupational health, safety and welfare standards within the Company.
